Passing is something immediate, something real, that approaches a coherent and vibrant multiplicity that is part of contemporary life. Passing moves people, displaces material and immaterial things, and, charged with transitive value, transfers something to others. By highlighting the act of passing from one place to another, inside a place or through it, Passing creates a new narrative capable of involving a wide community, inviting them to travel in, to cross, to pass through it.
